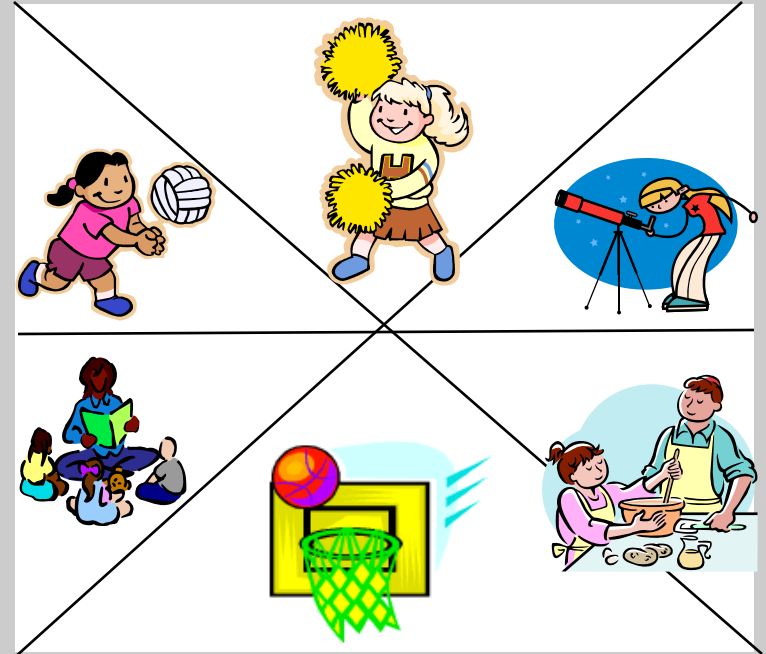

## REGISTRATION & FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Enrollment in the St. Michael Summer Program is open to all, regardless of race, creed, or nationality.

**REGISTER NOW:** Each St. Michael Summer Program has a limited enrollment and will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis; we are striving for quality, not quantity. Once a session is filled, further applicants will be placed on a waiting list, pending cancellations. We recommend registering early.

If a course has insufficient enrollment on May 27th, it will be canceled and tuition will be refunded.

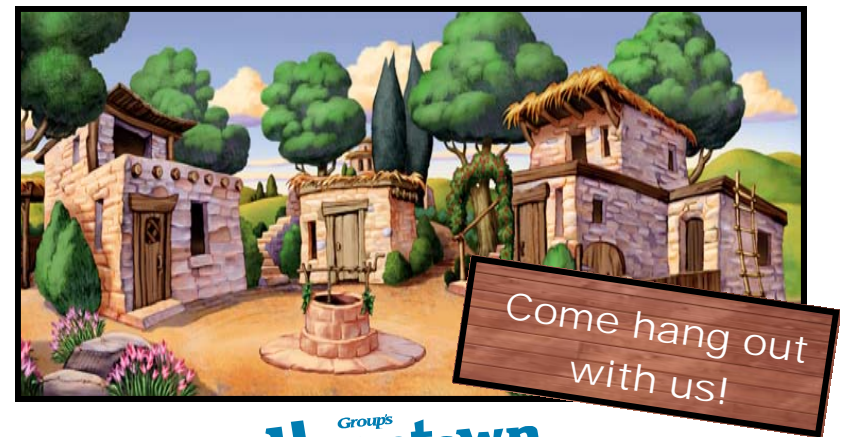
**FEES:** A **\$50 non-refundable registration fee** for each program enrolled is required with every registration. For example, if you enroll for two programs (even if they are within the same session) the registration fees would be \$100 (\$50 per program). **The registration fee is applied to the tuition of the program. The balance of the tuition is due on or before June 10th.** For late registrants (registrations submitted after June 8th), the full tuition must be paid at the time of registration. There will be a **\$25 fee for any check returned** to us by the bank because it was unable to be deposited.

**REFUNDS:** **Please note** - There is no refund for cancellation, either before the program begins or once the session has begun (including illness, injury, personal, etc.)

**PROGRAM CHANGES:** There will be a \$25 fee assessed for any change made after May 27th from your enrolled session or program to another session or program. No changes will be permitted once the session in which the child is enrolled has begun.

**TRANSPORTATION** is the responsibility of the parents. We can assist in providing contacts for car pools.

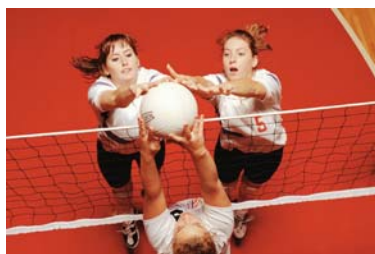

## Program Design:

Our program has been set up in a modular design in order to allow you the flexibility to select the time periods and programs that suit your needs and your child's interest.

A variety of two week programs are offered in half-day sessions. You may sign-up for mornings only, afternoons only, or both. Camp Discovery, our "day camp", can be selected on a full-day basis or as a half-day complement to one of the specialty programs.

Students should arrive on campus no more than 15 minutes before their program begins, and be picked-up promptly after dismissal.

**Program Plus** is offered as an extended care option, for those who need to arrive early, stay late, or both. Supervision is available from 7:30 A.M.-9:00AM and again from 3:45 P.M. - 5:30 P.M. daily; the fee is \$30 for a two week session for morning or afternoon, \$50 for both.

**Lunchtime Supervision** (12:00 - 12:45) will be provided free of charge to those who are enrolled in both morning and afternoon programs. If your child is not enrolled for the full day but wishes to bring a lunch to eat here, the supervision fee is \$20 for a two-week session.

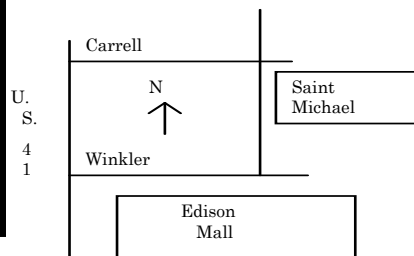
Those who are on campus all day will need to bring a sack lunch. Soda & juice machines are available.

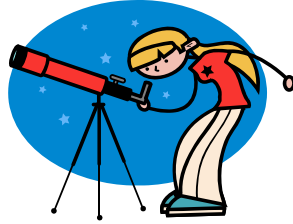

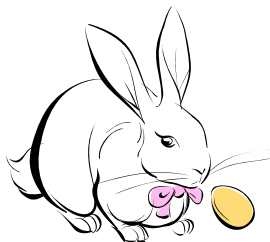
