My favorite food is: STEAK!



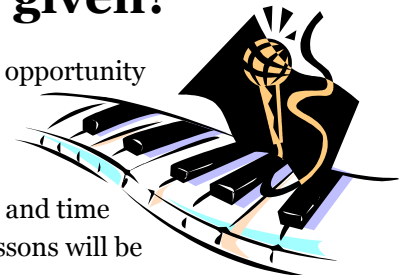
I was born and baptized: in West Virginia, and studied Music Education at both West Virginia Wesleyan College and West Virginia State College.

What is the cost?

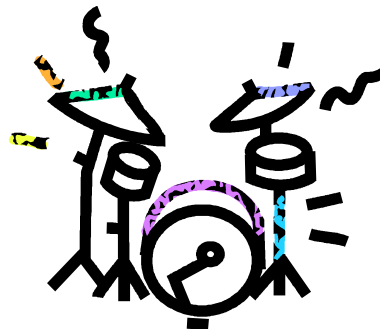
