Lessons will begin in September once Mrs. Jarvis has had an opportunity to visit classrooms, demonstrate the violin and share information about the Strings Program.

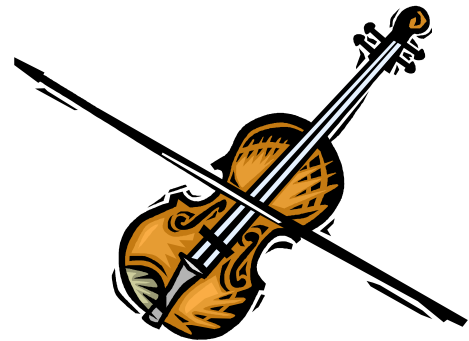
